A380 South Devon Link Road (SDLR)

Welcome to our latest monthly update which aims to provide residents and motorists with useful information as the SDLR scheme progresses. Available online as an ebulletin and emailed to individuals and stakeholders, subscription numbers for this monthly publication have increased dramatically over the past few weeks. Details on how to subscribe and receive these monthly updates are shown below.

We pride ourselves in engaging fully with residents, road users and the wider community, ensuring you are aware of the latest developments wherever possible. Our latest SDLR newsletter containing an informative map of the project will soon be distributed to local residents.

The SDLR project is advancing as planned and you can now see works being carried out along the existing A380 at Penn Inn, Sainsbury's, Aller and on the railway side near the Barn Owl. The bus stop has now reopened at Penn Inn for Torbay-bound commuters. A temporary bus stop sign has been erected while construction continues in the area of the bus stop.

Towards Hamelin Way, work on the haul road is also advancing, while in Kingskerswell groundwork is well underway at Kerswell Downs.

Below is an update on how we are progressing and what is planned for the next few months.

North Section – Penn Roundabout to The Barn Owl Pub

April

Completed works:

- Addison Road - closure of pedestrian footpaths onto Torquay Road.
- Addison Road - temporary one-way system during utility works.
- Closure of the pedestrian ramp at Sainsbury's.
- Commencement of the retaining wall behind Sainsbury's.
- Preliminary earthworks in the Barn Owl area.
- Installation of new boundary adjacent to Network Rail boundary.
- Commencement of retaining walls on east side of Torquay Road (St Luke's / Aller Park Roads).

May/June

Planned works:

- Continuation of work on retaining wall behind Sainsbury's.
- Continuation of earthworks in the Barn Owl area.
- Alignment of access routes in Sainsbury's car park.
- Ground preparation for the building of a retaining wall between the old railway bridge and the former Aller Cottages.
- Begin the piling for retaining walls on A380 at Aller Park Road and St Luke's Road.
- Road crossings at Hanson's Quarry and Aller Brake Road and across A380
- Site set-up within Penn Inn roundabout.
- Access for utility diversions and access into Keyberry Culvert area.

South Section – The Barn Owl Pub to Hamelin Way

April

Completed works:

- Completion and relocation of SDLR site compound.
- Works commence on Kingskerswell playground and Daccabridge Channel.
- Commencement of temporary haul road from Hamelin Way to Yon Street.
- Start of new car park at Maddacombe Road quarry (Kerswell Downs).
- Pre-earthworks drainage along South Section.

May/June

Planned works:

- Demolition of Elmcroft on Old Newton Road.
- Start of sewer diversions in preparation for environmental bund (Greenhill Road).
- Temporary plant crossings at Edginswell Lane, Maddacombe Road, Yon Street, Kingskerswell Road.
- Archaeological teams conduct detailed search along South Section.
- Start of sewer diversion in the field north of Aller Cross.
- Start of the Network Rail access road from Aller Cross.
- Start of Aller Brook Culvert north of Aller Cross.
- Sewer diversion adjacent to Parson's Footbridge near Edginswell.
- Relocation of timber yard near Edginswell.

Community Liaison Group

The Community Liaison Group is now well established and meets regularly in Kingskerswell. Made up in part of representatives from Torbay Council, Devon County Council and the contractor Galliford Try, the majority of the group comprises the people of South Devon who will either use or live alongside the new link road.

It provides an opportunity for group members to ask questions on your behalf about aspects of the construction of the road, as well as a way to pass on information regarding temporary road changes and news on forthcoming developments.
