A380 South Devon Link Road (SDLR)

Welcome to the latest of our monthly updates. The aim of these bulletins is to provide residents and motorists with information as the SDLR scheme progresses.

We place great importance on building strong communications links with residents, landowners and the wider community, ensuring you are aware of the latest developments wherever possible. The next SDLR Newsletter will soon be distributed to residents and local businesses, with the next update due to be published in July. Work on the SDLR is now well underway with the project growing rapidly as we move into summer. Below is a list of how the works have progressed so far and what is planned for the next few months.

North Section – Penn Roundabout to The Barn Owl Pub

March

Works commenced/completed:

- Tidying St Luke's and Aller Park residents' gardens.
- Residents' accommodation works – St Luke's Road.
- Removal of the large pine trees along Torquay Road.
- Penn Inn Roundabout / end of Addison Road wall construction.
- Addison Road – utility work (trenching and laying of new Western Power cabling and BT ducts).
- St Marychurch Road site clearance and fencing.
- Penn Inn bus stop – BT works to continue for approximately 8 weeks.

April/May

Planned works:

- Addison Road - closure of pedestrian footpaths onto Torquay Road.
- Addison Road - temporary one-way system during utility works.
- Closure of the pedestrian ramp at Sainsbury's mid April.
- Commencement of the retaining wall behind Sainsbury's.
- Aligning of access routes in Sainsbury's car park.
- Preliminary earthworks in the Barn Owl area.
- Preparation of ground for the building of a retaining wall between the old railway bridge and the former Aller Cottages.
- Commencement of retaining walls on east side of Torquay Road (St Luke/ Aller Park Roads).

South Section – The Barn Owl Pub to Hamelin Way

March

Works commenced/completed:

- Erection of reptile fence in preparation to relocate reptiles (grass snakes).
- Continued site clearance (99% complete).
- Start of demolition of property at 53 Daccabridge.
- Main site compound offices preparation.
- Continued fencing and accommodation works.

April/May

Planned works:

- Completion and relocation of site compound (off Old Newton Road).
- Works commence on Kingskerswell playground and Daccabridge Channel.
- Start of sewer diversions north of Yon Street in preparation for false cutting / environmental bund.
- Construction of temporary haul road from Hamelin Way to Yon Street.
- Temporary plant crossings at Edginswell Lane, Maddacombe Road, Yon St, Kingskerswell Road.
- Start of new car park at Maddacombe Road quarry (Kerswell Downs).

Community Liaison Group

The Community Liaison Group is now established and has regular meetings in Kingskerswell. This group has been set up to provide a vital link between local residents, Torbay Council, Devon County Council and the contractor Galliford Try. Members from all three organisations are represented on the group. Importantly, the majority of the group is made up of the people of South Devon who will either use or live alongside the link road.

It gives an opportunity for group members to ask questions relating to the construction of the road, along with information regarding temporary road changes and news on forthcoming developments.
