A380 South Devon Link Road

Welcome to the latest monthly bulletin. We hope you appreciate this view of S02, the Penn Inn Flyover, taken in the first week of September.

This month will see a three-week programme of works undertaken on the A380 north of Penn Inn Roundabout. These works will include kerb laying, surveying, pavement investigation and signage installation, as well as works on existing gullies.

To ensure the safety of road users and our construction workers, temporary lane restrictions and off-peak overnight road closures are required. Some of these may cause delays for which we apologise in advance.

When planning the works we have consulted South West Highways, who are managing the Teign Viaduct project, and where possible we have coordinated our works with theirs to minimise disruption to road users.

During this time we will also be working on the south side of the flyover which will require some lane restrictions. Full details of the programme, which is due to conclude on 18th September, can be found on the alerts section of our website here www.southdevonlinkroad.co.uk/alerts

At the southern end of the project, the new junction at Edginswell is scheduled to be completed later in the autumn, after which you will be able to travel on the new A380 South Devon Highway all the way from Hamelin Way to Penn Inn and beyond. After the road opens, the project will continue into 2016 with secondary works and landscaping to complete.

The new junction at Edginswell and those at the Aller area of Kingskerswell and Penn Inn Roundabout at Newton Abbot have prompted many enquiries about their configuration. To answer these questions we have produced a series of easy-to-understand drawings showing their layout. We will be posting these on the South Devon Link Road website soon, as well as distributing them to the local press for publication this month.

Below is a list of some of the work due to take place over the next few weeks. Much of the construction programme at this stage is weather-dependent and subject to revision.

North Section – Penn Inn roundabout to The Barn Owl pub

August commenced / completed works

- Painting on Penn Inn Flyover commenced (S02).
- Installation of kerb lines along Addison Road completed.
- Bow-top fencing installation along Addison Road commenced.



- Sign gantries installed at two locations on A380.
- Removal of existing highway near Addison Road and St Luke's Road completed.

September / October planned works

- Surfacing works north of Penn Inn to commence.
- Advance work for signage in Penn Inn area to commence.
- Construction of south ramp at Penn Inn to continue (S03).
- Installation of third sign gantry on northbound carriageway of A380 near Sainsbury's.
- Drainage excavations along sections of existing A380 to continue.
- Construction of new southbound carriageway from Addison Road to Hanson's Quarry to continue.
- Traffic realignments on existing A380 to continue.
- Realignment of Hanson's Quarry entrance to continue.
- Drainage works on Aller Railway Tunnel and Aller Road Overline Bridge to continue (S10, S11).

South Section – The Barn Owl to Hamelin Way

August commenced / completed works

- Traffic realignments, removal of roundabout and construction of new junction at Kerswell Gardens commenced.

September / October planned works

- Surfacing works on Yon Street Overbridge to continue (S14).
- Crash barrier installation along south section to continue.
- Diversion of Manor Drive stream to commence: weather-dependent.
- Stone cladding at Edginswell Lane Underbridge to continue (S35).
- Drainage works to continue along entire south section.
- Kerb drainage to continue along south section.
- Pavement construction along south section to continue.
- Construction of new junction at Kerswell Gardens to continue.
- Overnight traffic switch on Hamelin Way with overnight diversion to commence 21st September.
- Signage installation at Hamelin Way to commence.
- Street lighting installation at Edginswell Junction to commence.
- Traffic signals installation at Edginswell Junction to commence.

The total cost of the South Devon Link Road is estimated to be £110m. The Department for Transport has paid £76.39m towards the project. The balance is being shared equally between Torbay Council and Devon County Council, with Teignbridge District Council making a £500k contribution.
