## A380 South Devon Link Road (SDLR)

### Monthly Bulletin

Welcome to the September monthly bulletin giving you information about the SDLR project and what you may expect to see over the coming weeks.

Now the piling and earthworks have been completed at Aller, utilities diversions are taking place along the A380. During this operation one lane in each direction will remain open at all times but delays might be possible on Sundays 15<sup>th</sup> and 22<sup>nd</sup>. On these days Torbay-bound traffic will be diverted through the lay by at Romany Jones where we will have people on site to ensure traffic flows smoothly.

Further south, the permanent diversion at Churchway Lane, Kingskerswell, opens this month. Because the SDLR works cross a section of this narrow lane at the Maddacombe end of Greenhill Road the village end will be closed off. Walkers and horse riders will now be able to access the lane by joining the new path between Yon Street/Huxnor Road. They can follow this new pathway adjacent to the construction works which links up with Churchway Lane.

Towards the end of the month work will begin at St Marychurch Road. This will involve utilities diversions and the first stages of road widening. Traffic management will be in place at this location and up to date information will be posted on our website when the dates are finalised.

Below is a list of the works you may expect to see over the coming weeks. The project is divided up into distinct structures, each with its own unique 'S' reference number, and we have included these where appropriate. A full listing of the structure codes can be found on the South Devon Link Road website.

### North Section – Penn Inn roundabout to The Barn Owl

#### August

##### Commenced/completed works

- Steel fixing and carpentry works on retaining walls adjacent to Sainsbury's commenced (S06).
- Excavations to expose piles adjacent to St Luke's Road and Aller Park Road retaining walls completed.
- Utilities diversions adjacent to A380 and across Addison Road commenced.

#### September/October

##### Planned works

- Piling to commence in Penn Inn roundabout and retaining wall adjacent to Sainsbury's (S02 and S06).
- Soil nailing to commence on wall S06E at Sainsbury's.
- Sainsbury's culvert works - installation of large pre-cast culvert units continues (S22).
- Works on retaining walls at Aller continue (S08, S09).
- Earthworks continue in Barn Owl area and railway tunnel area (S10).
- Road crossings for utilities diversion at Romany Jones, Sundays 15<sup>th</sup> and 22<sup>nd</sup> September.
- Utilities works and widening commence on St Marychurch Road.

### South Section – The Barn Owl pub to Hamelin Way

#### August

##### Commenced/completed works

- Piling platforms for Yon Street overbridge commenced (S14).
- Environmental bund opposite Greenhill Road ongoing.

- Advance drainage culverts along South Section completed (S32, S31).
- Excavations of new east bound carriageway and slip road at Hamelin Way completed.

## September/October

### Planned works

- Reinforced concrete works continue at Aller Brook Culvert north of Aller Cross (S19).
- Excavations of Aller Road Underbridge continue (S12).
- Drainage and surfacing to Elmcroft Link Road commence.
- Main earthworks excavations north and south of Maddacombe Road continue.
- Churchway Lane diversion commences.
- Yon Street diversion utilities works continue.
- Advance drainage culverts along South Section continue (S28, S29).
- Reinforced concrete works at five culvert inlet/outlets commence (S28,29,31,32, 33).

## Community Liaison Group

The Community Liaison Group is now well established and meets regularly in Kingskerswell. The majority of the group comprises the people of South Devon who will either use or live alongside the new link road. Representatives from Torbay Council, Devon County Council and the contractor Galliford Try also attend.

It provides an opportunity for group members to ask questions on your behalf about aspects of the construction of the road, as well as a way to pass on information regarding temporary road changes and news on forthcoming developments.
