A380 South Devon Link Road (SDLR)

Welcome to the first bulletin of 2014. The Christmas works adjacent to Network Rail track at Aller and Kingskerswell went as planned with the removal of the accommodation bridge and the placing of three major culverts beneath the track.

Despite the poor weather the work was completed ahead of schedule without incident. We have not received a single complaint about the Christmas programme and would like to thank all local residents for their patience during these works.

The coming year will see major phases commence at Penn Inn with the construction of the two ramps and bridge section of the flyover, while in Torbay the widening of Hamelin Way into dual carriageway will continue. One of the largest and most impressive sections of the project during the first half of the year will be the commencement of a 270m-long tunnel over the railway line at Aller, which will carry the new A380. Elsewhere work will continue on the construction of the bridges at Maddacombe Road, Yon Street and Hamelin Way.

Before that commences, we have a section of Kingskerswell Road that will be closed for two nights on 14th and 15th January, 2014 between 19:00 to 07:00 to carry out essential utilities crossings. The works will take place between the junction with Old Newton Road and Aller Road and the railway bridge across the Plymouth and Penzance main railway line.

North Section – Penn Inn roundabout to The Barn Owl pub

- Accommodation bridge removal completed.
- Installation of Langford Flood Relief Culvert (S24).
- Installation of Aller Orchard Flood Relief Culvert (S25).
- Creation of cable jointing pit at Sainsbury's.

January/February

Planned works

- Penn Inn flyover bridge piers to commence (S02).
- Soil nailing and piling adjacent to Sainsbury's store to continue (S06).
- Building of reinforced walls at Sainsbury's to continue (S06).
- Construction of vibro columns adjacent to Sainsbury's (S06).
- Work on new car park realignment at Sainsbury's to continue
- Works on retaining walls at Aller to continue (S08, S09).
- Sainsbury's culvert works to continue (S22).
- Fencing and masonry wall works to continue at the rear of Aller Park Road and St Luke's Road (S05).
- Utilities crossing (two nights) Kingskerswell Road.

South Section – The Barn Owl pub to Hamelin Way

December

Commenced/completed works

- Installation of Manor Drive Flood Relief Culvert (S27).

- Piling at Gas Main structure commenced. (S36).

January/February Planned works

- Reinforced concrete works continue at Aller Brook Culvert north of Aller Cross (S19).
- North abutment to Aller Cross Underbridge to commence (S12).
- Main earthworks excavations north and south of Maddacombe Road to continue.
- Enabling works for Maddacombe Road Overbridge (S13).
- Yon Street utilities works to continue.
- Edginswell Lane utilities works continue.
- Reinforced concrete works at five culvert inlet / outlets continue (S28, 29, 31, 32, 33).
- Piling breakdown and preparatory work, Gas Main structure (S36).
- Cattle Creep reinforcement concrete work to commence (S18).
- Enabling work Torbay Ring Road Underbridge to commence (S34).
- Piling at south abutment, Torbay Ring Road Underbridge to commence (S34).

The total cost of the South Devon Link Road is estimated to be £110m. The Department for Transport has paid £76.39m towards the project. The balance is being shared equally between Torbay Council and Devon County Council, with Teignbridge District Council making a £500k contribution.
