Whereas it appears to Teignbridge District Council that works to which Section 61 of the Control of Pollution Act 1974 applies namely:

Particulars of works to be carried out:

- Cutting and excavation of trenches across the road.
- Placement of sheet piles for retaining wall structure and tie ins.
- Connecting tie rods through the excavations below the road and tie into anchor sheet piles constructed on the other side of the road.

at the premises known as:

Sainsbury Superstore, Penn Inn, Newton Abbot, Devon TQ12 1BN

NOTICE is HEREBY GIVEN that the following requirements must be complied with in connection with the carrying out of such works.

1. All work and ancillary operations including the operation of all machinery and equipment which are audible at the site boundary, or at such other place as may be agreed with the Council shall be carried out on the following dates and times during the 19th to 21st August 2013.

Hours of work: 1900 to 0500 hours


2. The best practicable means, as defined in Section 72 of the Control of Pollution Act 1974 to reduce noise shall be employed at all times.
3. Plant and machinery shall be properly silenced and maintained in accordance with the manufacturers' instructions.
4. Any emergency deviation from these conditions shall be notified to the undersigned without delay.
5. Permissible noise levels are not specified, but should not be at levels likely to cause a statutory nuisance at nearby residential dwellings.

6. The consent does not of itself constitute any ground of defence against any proceedings instituted under Section 82 of The Environmental Protection Act 1990 (Section 61 (9))

You may appeal against this notice to the Magistrates' Court within 21 days of service of the notice upon you.

In the event of an appeal this notice **SHALL NOT** be suspended until the appeal has been abandoned or decided by the Court as in the opinion of the Council.
