THE DEVON COUNTY COUNCIL (A380 SOUTH DEVON LINK ROAD (KINGSKERSWELL BYPASS) CLASSIFIED ROAD) (No.2 SIDE ROADS) ORDER 2009

THE SECRETARY OF STATE for Transport hereby gives notice that she has confirmed the above Orders which were made by Devon County Council, the former acting under an agreement with Torbay Council pursuant to Section 8 of the Highways Act 1980, in exercise of their powers under sections 14 and 125 of the Highways Act 1980 and which, as confirmed, authorises the Council to:

- a) improve highways;
- b) stop up highways;
- c) construct new highways;
- d) stop up private means of access to premises; and
- e) provide new means of access to premises,

all in the vicinity of the route of the classified road known as the A380 South Devon Link Road (Kingskerswell Bypass) which the Council is proposing to construct from Penn Inn Roundabout to Hamelin Way, Torquay.

ANY PERSON aggrieved by either or both of the Orders and desiring to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980 or on the ground that any requirement of that Act or of any regulations made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Orders, may, within 6 weeks of the 3 February 2012, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Orders or of any provision contained therein.
